2024 Grants



*** HARTFORD HEALTHCARE**

Project Purple has awarded a \$750,000 grant to Hartford HealthCare to establish Connecticut's largest high-risk pancreatic cancer screening program. This initiative aims to improve early detection, increase accessibility, and enhance patient outcomes, with the goal of creating a model that can be expanded nationwide.



*** DUKE UNIVERSITY**

Project Purple awarded \$250,000 to Duke University researchers, including \$150,000 to Dr. Peter Allen for studying IPMN sub-types and \$100,000 to Dr. Elishama Kanu for genomic profiling of high-risk biomarkers. An additional \$100,000 was granted to complete Duke's Prevention of Progression to Pancreatic Cancer Trial.




*** UNIVERSITY OF ILLINOIS CANCER CENTER**

Project Purple awarded a \$75,000 grant to Dr. Paul Grippo of the University of Illinois Cancer Center to support research on using CRF technology with endoscopic ultrasound for early pancreatic cancer detection. This funding, in collaboration with the Team Carone Foundation, aims to improve early diagnosis and treatment.




